### **Open House/Public Meeting for Proposed Improvement of 95<sup>th</sup> Street at Stony Island Avenue Intersection set for June 5**

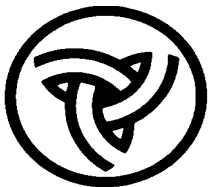
**Chicago** – The Illinois Department of Transportation (IDOT) will host a public meeting to discuss the proposed intersection improvement of 95<sup>th</sup> Street (U.S. Route 12/20) at Stony Island Avenue in the City of Chicago. The scope of work for this improvement is anticipated to consist of intersection reconstruction, bridge replacement, signal modernization, lighting improvements, and drainage improvements.

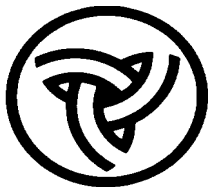
